- Intermediate—2nd 1/3 of Belt System
- Advanced—3rd 1/3 of Belt System
- Example: 10 Kyu Ranks
 - Novice—10th Kyu –7th Kyu
 - Intermediate—6th Kyu –4th Kyu
 - Advanced—3rd Kyu –1st Kyu

• 2 Splits—Novice; Advanced

- Novice—1st 1/2 of Belt System
- Advanced—2nd 1/2 of Belt System
- Example: 9 Kyu Ranks
 - Novice—9th Kyu –5th Kyu
 - Advanced—4th Kyu –1st Kyu

***Note: Intermediate+Advanced = Intermediate Ranks and Advanced Ranks

Mandatory Gear:

Weapons – Max height of Bo is 6' weapons must be made of solid material, no hollow weapons, weapons must be safe, no live or sharp blades.

Self Defense – Both Competitor and Attacker MUST wear head gear. Cannot turn any weapon on Attacker.

Chanbara – Must have own helmet with facemask and foam sword. Max sword length is 40"

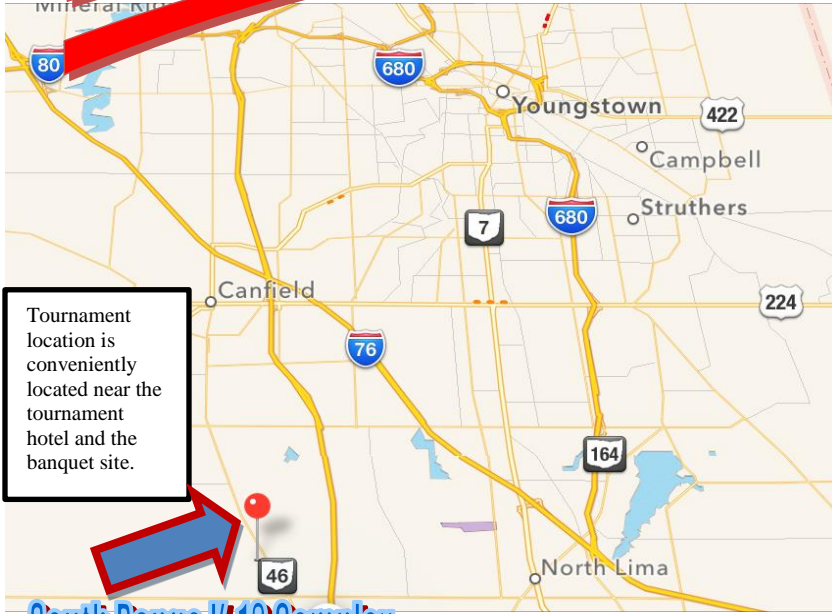
Sparring – Must have own vinyl or foam dipped feet, hand, and headgear, mouthpiece, and groin protector for males.
